Guest Skating Policy

Definitions

Guest skaters are:

- 1. NDSC skaters who wish to skate on a session they are not currently registered for; or
- 2. Non-NDSC skaters, that are Skate Canada members, who would like to skate on an NDSC ice session.

Fees

NDSC Members - \$25 for 2 hours, \$15 for 1 hour

Non-NDSC Members - \$40 for 2 hours, \$20 for 1 hour

Guest-Lesson (NDSC Members only) - \$10 per lesson, includes 5 min warm-up and 15 min lesson. Coach's fees not included.

Policies

General

- Approval is subject to availability
- Skaters can only guest skate on a session for which they meet the requirements
- Non-NDSC Members and their Parents/Guardians must adhere to NDSC Skater Code of Conduct and Parent Code of Conduct, respectively.
 - If skaters and/or Parents/Guardians violate the Codes of Conduct, they may be asked to leave the session, without a refund, and/or may be denied future sessions.
- Non-NDSC Members are restricted to a maximum of 5 guest skates per session. If more than 5 guest skates are requested, then the skater is required to register for the entire session.
- Priority for music playing is given to NDSC skaters and coaches. Guest skaters may ask an NDSC coach to play their music.

StarSkate Star 3+ Skaters

Non-NDSC members are not required to be accompanied by an approved coach.

StarSkate Star 1-2 Skaters

Non-NDSC members must be accompanied by an approved coach.

CanSkate & Rising Star Skaters

Restricted to NDSC Members only

- Must register for a 15-minute guest-lesson. Skaters are allowed a 5 minute warm up prior to their lesson.
- The skater or parent/guardian must contact a coach of their choosing prior to submitting the guest skating request form.
- Skaters may only receive lessons during Rising Star or Star 1 sessions.

Procedures

Before arriving at the arena and stepping on the ice:

- The skater/coach/parent/guardian must complete and submit the 'Guest Skate Request' on the NDSC website.
- Guest skating requests must be submitted 3 days prior to the desired guest skating session.
 - Late requests are not guaranteed.
- Upon approval, the session(s) must be paid in full in advance of the session.
 - Payment by EMT or Credit Card only.
 - Requests for cash payment must be sent to ndsc.comm@gmail.com (NDSC Skaters ONLY)
 - The memo/message must include the skater's name and session date.
- Coaches accompanying guest skaters must be in good standing with Skate Canada, and be granted coaching privileges by the Board of Directors prior to the session.
